Tamborine Mountain Scout Group is situated on approximately 4 acres of land at 127 Hartley Road, Tamborine Mountain.

The Group's Heritage Den was moved to its current location in June 2021, and is over 100 years old. Recent building works include the bitumen carpark, Quartermaster's Store, Den roof replacement, new kitchen and internal painting. Plans are underway for an undercover shelter with camp kitchen, signage and safety bollards.

## ATTENDANCE & DEPARTURE

### Prior to Arrival:

- Obtain hire key lock box code from Group representative.

### Prior to Departure:

- Ensure all areas of the Den, including toilets, are cleaned. Cleaning products are located within the kitchen.
- Ensure the air-conditioning unit has been turned off if used.
- Ensure Den is locked and keys returned to lock box with combination scrambled and safety cover closed.
- Liaise with Group representative to confirm numbers for invoicing.

## CONDITIONS FOR ALL HIRERS

- **Please note that members of the public may attempt to enter our grounds, as the local parkrun circuit includes the outer boundaries. Vigilance is recommended if youth members are in attendance.** Hirers have the right to challenge any person traversing our lease area.
- Consumption of alcohol and smoking (includes e-cigarettes) are prohibited on site.
- **No loud noise permitted after 9:00pm and before 7:00am. Please be respectful of our neighbours. Inappropriate behaviour may result in removal from our site.**
- No pets or generators permitted on site.
- Care is to be taken when travelling on Hartley Road; this is a narrow residential street with limited lighting.
- Care is to be taken if walking within our site boundaries. Tamborine Mountain Landcare has an ongoing program of weed removal and native tree planting; members are to remain clear of barricaded areas and protected saplings.

## FACILITIES

- The Den operates on tank water; all hirers are required to bring sufficient drinking water supplies for their hire period.
- The toilets operate on a site-specific sewerage system; no foreign matter is to be placed into the toilets or kitchen sink.
- There are no showers; hirers are recommended to bring their own camp shower equipment.
- There is no running hot water; our kitchen is equipped with jugs and urns.
- All hirers are required to bring their own cooking equipment, utensils, gas supplies and first aid kits.

## CAMPFIRES

- There is a designated campfire pit located immediately south of the Den; all campfires are to be conducted in this pit.
- No rubbish is to be burned in the campfire.
- Hirers will be required to supply their own water to extinguish their campfire.
- Hirers will be required to bring their own logs for burning however kindling is readily available in the surrounding bush land.

## RUBBISH & RECYCLING

- All rubbish is required to be removed by the hirer.
- All suitable recyclable items are to be placed into the Scout Recycling Centre wheelie bins.
